### Flu vaccination for your child - Reception to Year 6

This year, all children in Reception to Year 6 are being offered a flu vaccination in school. The vaccination will be given in the form of a simple spray up the nose. It is painless, very quick, and the side effects are uncommon and generally mild. By having the flu vaccination, children are less likely to pass the virus to friends and family, especially those who may be at greater risk from flu, such as infants, elderly people or friends and family with a serious health condition. This will also help reduce further strain on the NHS as a result of the coronavirus pandemic.

The NHS School Immunisation Team will be attending our school on Tuesday, 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021 to carry out the vaccinations for any child that requires it in Reception to Year 6.

Your child will bring home an envelope today which contains information and a consent form which you must complete and return to the school office by Friday, 24<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Forms must be returned by these dates to allow the Immunisation team enough time to order the correct amount of vaccine.

A completed form must be returned to school for each child even if you do not want your child to have the vaccine. Please complete the relevant section indicating whether you give consent or do not wish for your child to take part in the programme.
