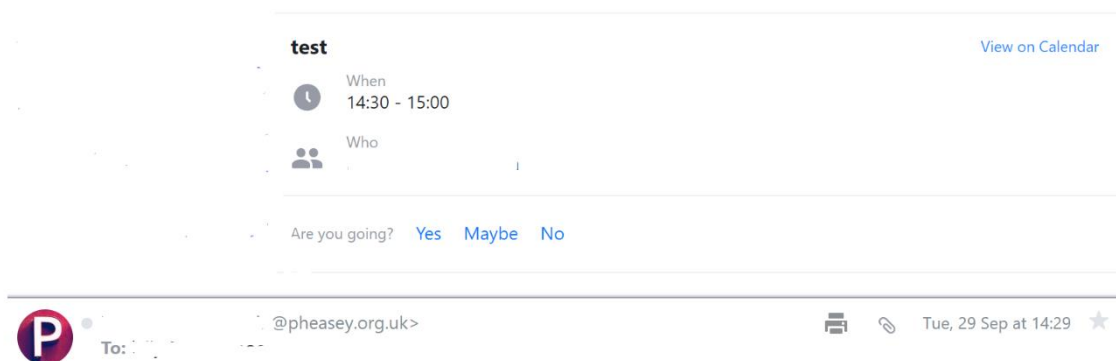
Guide for Parents and Carers accessing appointments via a Laptop/PC/Desktop

Parents' evening appointments are scheduled by your child's Class Teacher via a Teams Meeting. Please expect an appointment invite to the email that school currently has on file.

Please note that this appointment will be to discuss how your child has settled into school and will not make reference to academic progress at this point. There will be a 5-minute time allocation in order to ensure that each parent can be catered for and that staff can be off-site to allow for deep cleaning.

How to Access Your Teams Appointment for Parents' Evening on a Laptop/PC/Desktop


- First, sign into your email account. (The one that school currently has).
- Open the email sent by your child's class teacher.

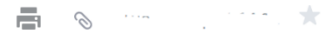

- Click on 'Join Microsoft Teams Meeting.'

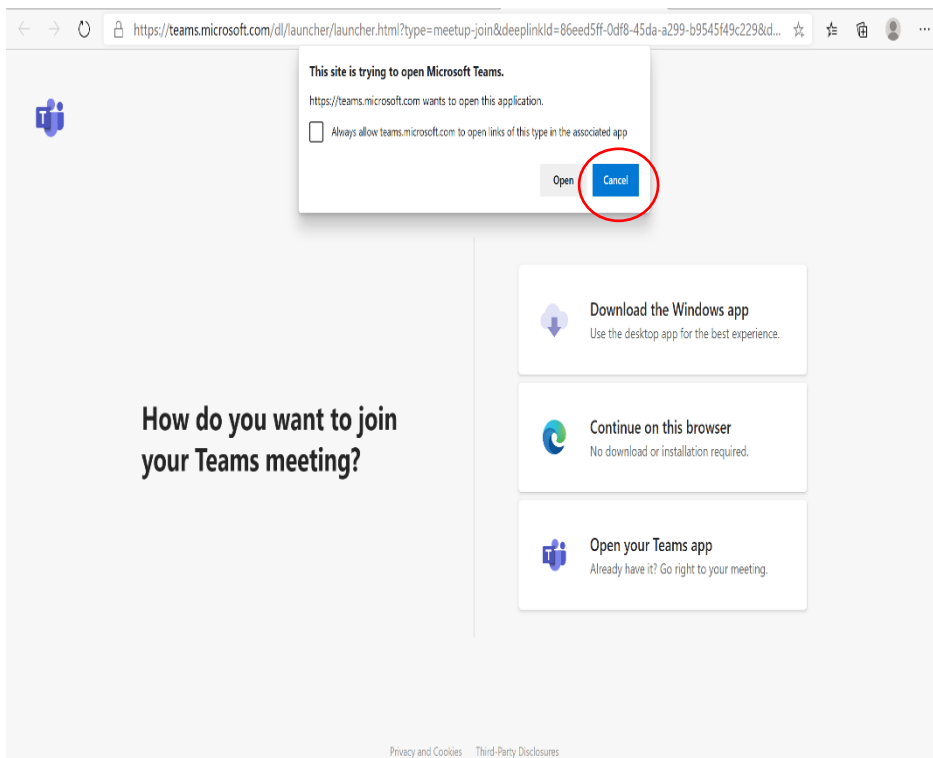

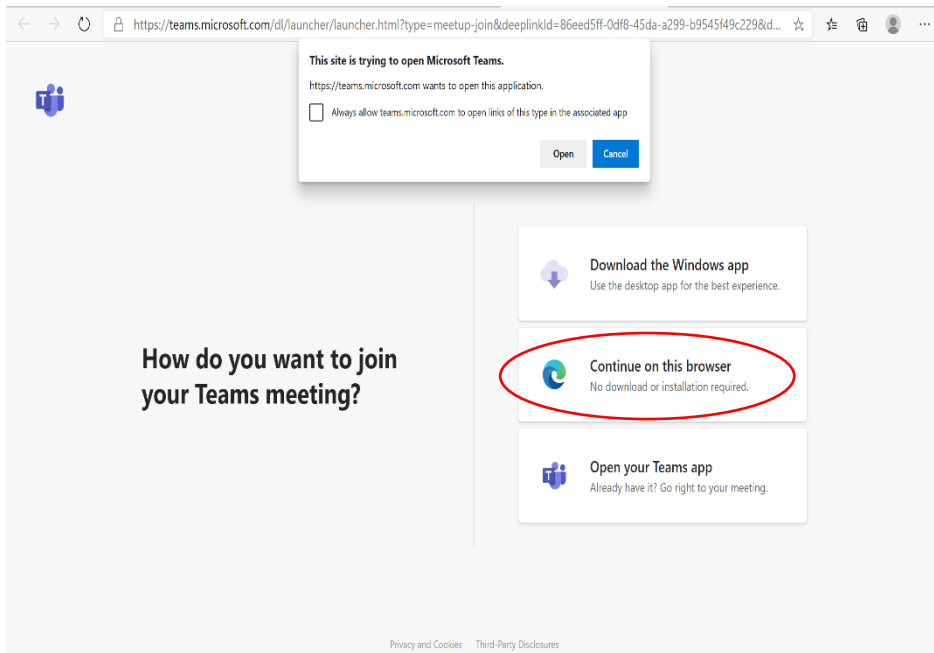

This will then open a new page on the current web page.




- Click 'Cancel' to it opening it on Microsoft Teams.

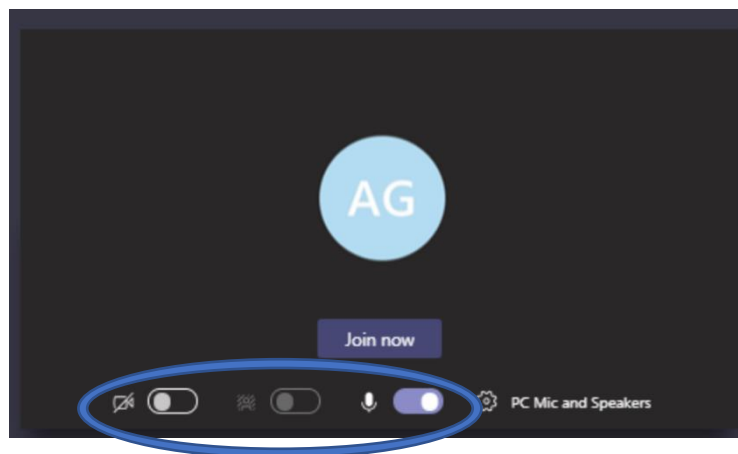


- Click on, 'Continue on this browser'. This will mean you will not need to install Teams on your device.

- When it is your appointment time, click 'Join' in the middle of the screen.

- You can now choose whether to set your camera  and

microphone  to on or off, using the 'toggle' icons shown below. If the icon has a 'strikethrough,' then it is off.



Advice for Teams Meetings

- Ensure everyone in your household knows you are in a Teams meeting and that your camera will be switched on (if choosing this option).
- Take care to eliminate background noise.
- If an echo occurs, try muting your microphone and then unmuting it when you would like to speak.
