'Hello Yellow'

We are pleased to inform you that on Friday, 8th October 2021, we will be supporting Young Minds' 'Hello Yellow' fundraising campaign. This will link with World Mental Health Day, which is marked on 10th October 2021. The campaign encourages everyone to "Come together and celebrate the little things we can do to look after ourselves and support each other's mental health."

It can be hard to stay positive sometimes but we all need to practise self-care, consider our mental health and also support others who may need it.
