Dear Parents and Carers,

YEAR 6 VISIT TO WOODLANDS

We are pleased to inform parents and carers that we are still able to proceed with a Year 6 school trip for the children despite recently attending the Whitemoor Lakes trip. On Thursday 9th June 2022 Year 6 children will be visiting Woodlands Adventure & Outdoor Learning. We have been offered a special price for the visit and in order for us to receive this, a deposit of £22.00 must be paid by Thursday 4th November 2021. The total cost of the visit is £42.00 per child which includes the coach travel, entrance fee, and insurance.

The coach will leave school at 9:00am, so please make sure you arrive at school on time at 8:40am to allow children time to be registered and to visit the toilet before leaving the building. The coach will park on Wimperis Way and children will be escorted out of school via the back footpath.

The coach will arrive to collect children from the venue at 4:00pm, therefore children will be dismissed from the Wimperis Way gate at approximately 4.30pm. Further information will follow closer to the time regarding dismissal arrangements.

Staff have visited the venue beforehand and careful planning and risk assessments have been carried out. The children will travel on a coach with seat belts and be supervised in a ratio of 1 adult to 10 children.

The following clothing has been advised for the children to wear for the activities and children should arrive at school wearing these items:

- Full length loose bottoms e.g. jogging bottoms - jeans and leggings are not permitted
- T-Shirt - long sleeved or short sleeved
- Sweatshirt/hoody
- Trainers
- Waterproof jacket
- Sunhat/cap if the weather is sunny

Each child should also bring a small rucksack with them containing a complete spare set of clothes, including underwear and footwear, to wear on the return journey should they get very wet/muddy



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(please note leggings/jeans will be permitted as the spare items). Children should also pack in their rucksack a towel, packed lunch with snacks and plenty of drinks for the day. All items must fit into one small bag only. If the weather is hot, please apply suncream to your child at home to last for the day. If you child holds an inhaler/medication in school, this will be taken to the venue by School staff.

We will confirm activities and consent required by Woodlands closer to the time, however Woodlands do offer activities such as orienteering, zip line, archery and assault course.

This deposit is non refundable as it will be used to secure your child's place at Woodlands. The remaining balance of £20.00 must be paid by **Thursday 27th January 2022**. Parents do have the option to pay in full by Thursday 4th November 2021 if they prefer. Please note that once numbers are confirmed, additional children cannot be added on at a later date.
